Farmers Mutual Insurance Company of Ellinwood, Kansas was organized on April 12, 1896. The company is located in Ellinwood, Kansas which is a town of about 2,500 located in Barton County in the heart of Kansas.

The statutes of the organization, as published in 1899, recorded that the organization was called the “Union of German Farmers of Barton County and Vicinity, Kansas”. The purpose of the organization was to “Support, instruct, and promote custom in cooperation with the Farmers in a mutual way”. Over the years the company has adopted as its motto, “The Mutual Way.”

The term “Mutual Way” is synonymous with mutual insurance or a cooperative such as the Farmers Coop organization. The Union of Farmers of Barton County was a combination of these two types of organizations.

Today the company operates throughout the state of Kansas through a network of over 125 independent agencies in almost every county of Kansas. The company provides property insurance in all counties of Kansas primarily through the independent insurance agency system. They provide Homeowner, Farmowner, City Fire and Farm Fire insurance coverages.

Stingray, one of the most advanced insurance processing software systems, keeps this 100+ year old company humming. With Stingray’s state of the art Geo Coding risk concentration module, the company can keep track of its exposure on a real time basis. Likewise, Stingray interfaces the Boeckh Property Replacement Cost Interface to all submissions.

With a number of agents throughout the state, Farmers has been able to enforce the U S Patriot Act requirements via Stingray’s exclusive agent web portal module whereby agents can place business, effect endorsements and maintain customer records online and in real time.
